DIEGO FRANZIN HEAD OF EQUITIES



As Head of Equities, Diego Franzin manages the active equity business line at Amundi Asset Management across investment centers in Dublin, London, Paris, Milan, Vienna, Munich and Tokyo. Based in Dublin, Diego is directly responsible for the investment process, research function and management of all portfolios within European equity, Global equity, Volatility, Convertible Bonds, Equity Overlay solutions, Thematics and Japanese Equity.

Prior to this, Diego was Head of Equity – Europe in Amundi Asset Management (previously Pioneer Investments). In this position he led the fundamental bottom up active equity investment process across European and Global Thematic strategies since 2011. He started his career in 1998 in the research department and became Head of Global Quantitative Research & Management, responsible for a global team of quantitative research analysts supporting all asset classes and managing quantitative funds.

Diego is a graduate in Economics from the University of Pavia with specialisation in econometrics and statistics. He joined Amundi Asset Management in April 1998 as a Quantitative Equity Analyst and became Head of Global Quantitative Equity and Head of U.S. Quantitative Research in 2002 before assuming the role as Head of Global Quantitative Research & Management in April 2008. In 2011 was promoted to Head of Equity- Europe overseeing both the quantitative and fundamental investment processes.

Diego completed the Harvard Business School PLD5 (Programme for Leadership Development) in 2008.
